



Information Sheet

➤ Registration Information:

- Youth must register through their parish.
- All hard copy registrations and shirt orders are due by Thursday, September 20th.
- Online registrations will stay open until the end of the day on Thursday, September 27th.
- Parishes are responsible for obtaining all Parental Consent Forms, which can be found on the website, and mailing them along with the group registration form. You can also turn them in at check-ins the morning of the event.
- T-shirt order forms can be found on the website. Orders are due by September 20th. Late orders will **not** be accepted. Money will be returned for orders sent in after the 20th.
- Parish leaders can pick up any ordered T-shirts at the event check-in.
- Individuals or Families wishing to attend with a local parish or register separately can contact Kara Kardell for assistance (karak@scdiocese.org).

➤ The cost of attending the Youth Conference is as follows:

- Youth registrations are \$35 and adult registrations are \$30.
- Registrations are non-refundable.

➤ Who can attend:

- Any youth in 7-12 grade.
- Parish adult chaperones – a ratio of 1 adult per 8 youth is required within your group.
- Parishes are responsible for the Safe Environment training and Driver forms (if driving) for all adults.

➤ Conference Schedule:

- Youth Conference will begin with check-ins at **10:45am-11:15am** and end at **8:00pm**.
- Doors will open at 10:45 am.
- Lunch and Dinner will be provided and is included in the registration costs.
- Mass with Bishop Nickless, Adoration, and Confession will be included in the event's schedule.
- Adults need to remain at the conference with their youth for the entirety of the day.
